Initiate rhythms of gathering and outreach to build momentum

CAMPUS PARTNERS

willing to support planting efforts

- Multiple students responsive to invitations and development
- A growing network of 15+ interested campus contacts
- Spiritual and/or administrative openness on campus
- 2+ partners interested in supporting the community

EMERGING

A witnessing community has formed on campus

LAUNCH THE COMMUNITY to engage the campus

Start a campus prayer meeting and/or Bible study

Develop a culture of invitation through network mapping

Disciple students and partners into greater love for God and the campus

Gather a core team of apprentices who are reaching out in their networks

APPRENTICES being disciplined towards influence

- 3+ committed apprentices
- At least one vibrant structure involving 5+ participants
- Consistent rhythms of outreach that engage the diversity of the campus
- Students attend a weekend event/conference

A CORE GROUP OF STUDENTS &/OR FACULTY that have said yes to ongoing leadership of the ministry

ESTABLISHING

A witnessing community is developing on campus

GROW A TEAM to lead the community

Integrate space to encounter God throughout structures

Incorporate periodic calls to faith throughout the community

Develop a Leaders Team to disciple others, engage their networks, and lead the ministry

Leverage catalytic events to build momentum for the community

LEADERS discipling others and influencing their community

- A team of 5+ leaders/partners aligned with our vision/purpose
- Chapter involves network of 30+ overall participants
- New people are coming to faith in Jesus
- Students attend intensive discipleship experiences (e.g., camp, GP, etc.)

LEADERS SENT OUT AS WITNESSES to new corners of campus

CATALYZING

The witnessing community is engaging multiple corners and/or campuses

MULTIPLY IMPACT to diverse corners and/or campuses

Utilize communal practices to deepen life with God and contend for breakthrough

Ask "who is not in the room?" and engage underserved corners and/or campuses

Create developmental experiences to equip students and partners to reach new corners of campus

Leverage opportunities for synergy between corners to sustain and grow impact

NETWORK LEADERS empowering others and creating missional systems

- Multi-level student leadership structure with consistent apprenticeship
- 5+ small groups that are bearing witness to new corners of campus
- Decision rate of 10%+
- Partners and alumni decide to serve as staff/volunteers
